- \*\*If you are interested in a "Limited" enrollment type program, please consider registering in the first two days! Many programs fill up fast!
- \*\*Usually registration lines are quite long. It is not necessary to bring your child to registration.
- \*\*RESIDENT POLICY: The current policy states that a non-resident fee will be charged to participants who DO NOT physically reside in Houlton.
- \*\*Checks may be payable to the Houlton Recreation Department. However, do not fill in the amount until the time of registration as some programs may be full.



# **Science Camp**

#### **Space Tour**

We'll start this class by designing rockets to "Blast Off" into learning about our Solar System. We'll do some experiments to learn about each of the planets and we'll also do some activities to see how astronauts use special gear to do their jobs! Take your rocket home and anything else you make!

#### **Soil- Wait what?**

We're going to learn about dirt? You bet! There are so many organisms living in the soil that sometimes it's considered to be living itself! We'll take a closer look at soil from different places and learn how it actually forms. We'll also study some of the organisms that live in soil and learn how we can create healthy soils. You'll get to plant your own and bring it home! \* Spoiler alert - the seed you will plant will grow a Mimosa Pudica (Sensitive plant) that moves on its own when you touch its leaves!

Think about your favorite plant or animal, now image you zoom in on it with a microscope. What would you see? What makes up plants, animals and other things? We'll take a closer look and learn about the tiny world around us. Students will do an experiment in which they extract their own DNA from cheek cells and make it into a necklace to bring home!

When most kids think of scientists they think of mixing brightly colored liquids in test tubes. We'll do a little of that and a little of this and create some cool science "toys" to bring home to amaze friends and family.
